Item 6.2 Principal's Report – Lynette Wardle

- Our school population is 522 students, down slightly from previous year.
- We have 23 classes, most in Primary.
- Listing of all new staff members and assignments. Vice—Principal, Mrs. Whale, off until Thanksgiving. Retired Vice-Principal currently filling in until Mrs. Whale's return.
- We had a great turnout at Meet the Teacher night. Our Book Fair was successful.
- Safe and Caring Schools week is currently underway. The goal is to promote safe and healthy Catholic school communities within our school board. Each day carries a specific theme, prayers and morning announcements. Gospel readings take place within the individual classes. Today's action regarded the Biblical story of the prodigal son. Children are encouraged to reflect upon opportunities for forgiveness.
- Emergency drills and "hold and secure" drills took place in our school. Note that the "hold and secure" differs from a "lock down." In a hold and secure procedure there is a known concern in the outside community, and measures are made to ensure the safety of all persons within the school. A lock down procedure occurs when there is a threat within the school.
- We have three mandatory fire drills in cool weather and three again in warmer weather.
- Our community liason officer will engage in school drills and support our staff with updated procedures.
- Next week, *X Movement* is scheduled. It will be a busy four days at school with student activities and the parent event on the September 29th. On parent night, families will be engaged in X Movement activities, promoting physical activity, positive sportsmanship and

- character building. In the event of rain, the gym and additional space within school will be used.
- Grades 3 8 cross country to take place on September 29. These grades will be scheduled for X Movement on alternate dates.
- We have a new priest, Fr. Tom, at St. Isaac Jogues Church. Our first school mass is October 11, 2016. Students and staff will travel by bus to St. Isaac Jogues Church for this mass.
- The Grade 4's will participate in a bible celebration on October 4, 2016.
- Our Terry Fox Run is scheduled for October 7, 2016.
